

The Following is a Proposed Amendment for inclusion with The Constitution of the United States upon ratification of at least ¾ of the many states that comprise United States:

AMENDMENT XXVIII

DURING TIMES OF VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES

During times of vacancy in the office of the President of the United States in which there is no living member of the human species who is the President for at least one hour the senior officer in the United States Marine Corps currently on active duty as determined by rank and date of rank shall be invested with the following powers responsibilities and obligations until a vacancy in the office of the President of the United States no longer exists:

1. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank in all individual instances in which a vacancy has existed in the office of the President of the United States for at least one hour has power to assume the rank of a five star general for the duration of the vacancy in the office of the President of the United States and issue orders which must be obeyed to the extent the individual orders issued are within the powers granted to the senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank by all members of the armed forces of the United States who are currently on active duty to include the Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, Army, Coast Guard and the Nation Guard as the Commanding General of all armed forces of the United States independent of civilian oversight, independent of executive orders issued by a President, and independent of acts of the United States Congress to include acts of the United States Congress which have been passed into law to include power to compel throw force of arms a stand down of operations of the armed forces of the United States involving atomic, nuclear, or thermonuclear munitions with the exception of power to order or compel throw force of arms the employment of atomic, nuclear, or thermonuclear munitions. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank does not have the power to order or compel throw force of arms the employment of atomic, nuclear, or thermonuclear weapons.
2. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank shall locate the Vice President and upon locating the Vice President shall ensure the Vice President is presented with a copy of the oath of office of the President of the United States, a judge of a court in the United States, and a videographer or ten thousand witnesses to facilitate the swearing in of the Vice President as the President in all individual instances in which the Vice President is not deceased or otherwise is incapable of being sworn into office as the President of the United States and a vacancy has existed in the office of the President of the United States for at least an hour.
3. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank in instances in which a vacancy exists in the office of the President of the United States which has existed for at least 12 consecutive hours and the Vice President is deceased or otherwise incapable of being sworn into office as the President of the United States the senior officer currently on duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank has power to compel throw force of arms the assembly of the House of Representatives in all individual instances in which the House of Representatives can be assembled into a quorum to facilitate the House of Representatives seeing to obligations related to choosing a President as defined in section 4 of the 20th amendment of The Constitution of the United States and as defined in this amendment to The Constitution of the United States until a new President has been chosen who meets qualification requirements to be the President as defined in the Constitution of the United States. In all individual instances in which a vacancy exists of a duration of at least 12 consecutive hours in the office of the President of the United States the House of Representatives has power which is being granted to the House of Representatives upon ratification of this amendment by at least ¾ of the many states which comprise the United States as an amendment to The Constitution of the United States to select who will become the President in all individual instances in which a vacancy in the office of the President of the United States has existed for at least 12 consecutive hours, the Vice President is deceased or is otherwise incapable of being sworn into office as the President of the United States, and at least a quorum of the House of Representatives is present by reaching a consensus of at least sixty percent of all individual members of the House of Representatives who are physically present in the form of a recorded vote as to who the President of the United States will be and upon selection of a President the individual selected by the House of Representatives as the individual who is to become the President will become the President upon being sworn into office as the President of the United States by a judge of any court in the United States with a videographer present or at least ten thousand witnesses present to provide proof the President was sworn into office as the President of the United States.
4. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank does not have power to prevent the House of Representatives or the Senate from assembling regardless of whether or not a vacancy exists in the office of the President of the United States, the senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank does not have power to prevent the House of Representatives from forming a quorum, the senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank does not have power to prevent the House of Representatives from choosing a President in all individual instances in which a vacancy exists in the office of the President of the United States and the Vice President is deceased or otherwise incapable of being sworn into office as the President of the United States.
5. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank shall ensure the House of Representatives chooses a President to occupy the office of the President of the United States who meets qualification to be the President as defined in The Constitution of the United States in all individual instances in which the House of Representatives can be assembled into a quorum, a vacancy exists in the office of the President of the United States for at least 12 consecutive hours, and the Vice President is deceased or otherwise unable to be sworn into office as the President of the United States.
6. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank has power to compel throw force of arms the assembly of state legislatures in all individual states throughout the United States for purposes related to filling vacancies in the Senate and for purposes related to filling vacancies in the House of Representatives anytime vacancies exist in the House of Representatives in sufficient quantity to prohibit the assembly of the House of Representatives into a quorum and a vacancy of a duration of at least 12 hours exists in the office of the President of the United States.
7. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank does not have power to prevent individual legislatures of the many states which comprise the United States from assembling during any time regardless of whether a vacancy exists in the office of the President of the United States.
8. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank has power to obtain from any branch of the Federal Reserve Banking System any amount of money up to a limit of one hundred billion dollars in all individual instances in which a vacancy in the office of the President of the United States exists for at least twelve consecutive hours, the Federal Reserve Banking System has power and shall to grant the senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank any amount of money up to a limit of one hundred billion dollars upon request from the senior officer on active duty in the United States Marine Corps in all individual instances in which a vacancy exists in the office of the President of the United States for a duration of at least 12 consecutive hours, the Department of Treasury has power and obligation to reimburse the Federal Reserve Banking System from freshly printed currency for all funds provided to the senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank money the Federal Reserve Banking System provided to the senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank during a time in which a vacancy has existed in the office of the President of the United States for at least 12 consecutive hours.
9. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank shall obtain throw purchase a meeting place for both houses of the United States Congress and residences for all individual members of both houses of the United States Congress which in the judgment of the senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank can be secured against assault throw force of arms in any individual instance in which the Capitol Building in the District of Columbia in the judgment of the senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank is no longer a suitable place for the United States Congress to meet in the judgment of the senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank and a vacancy exists in the office of the President of the United States for a duration of at least 12 consecutive hours.
10. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank has power to give instructions to all services, agencies, departments, and commissions of the United States which must be seen to including power to compel the cooperation of employees of individuals services, agencies, departments and commissions of the United States throw force of arms in all individual instances in which a vacancy exists in the office of the President of the United States for at duration of least 12 consecutive hours.
11. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank has power to prevent egress of citizens of the United States and individuals who are not citizens of the United States into other regions of the United States throw force of arms in all individual instances in which in the judgment of the senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank citizens of the United States and individuals who are not citizens of the United States need to be prevented from egressing into individual regions of the United States to prevent failure of individual regions of the United States during anytime a vacancy exists in the office of the President of the United States of a duration of at least 12 hours.
12. The senior officer currently on active duty in the United States Marine Corps as determined by rank and date of rank shall ensure the survival of the United States to the extent the survival of the United States can be ensured without placing into danger the ability of all civilization to exist on Earth without respect to the survival of individual civilizations in individual nation states outside the borders of the United States.

The preceding proposed amendment to The Constitution of the United States is a creation of Patrick Clinton Stevenson who is a private citizen of the United States named sovereign of the United States by God and by the Creator and not a creation of a member of the House of Representatives of the United States or the creation of a Senator of the United States.
